 - The Union Government notified the appointment of **2 new Judges of Supreme Court of India.**
 - With this appointment, the Supreme Court of India has regained its full strength of **34 Judges**.
 - 2 newly appointed judges are:

Rajesh Bindal - Chief Justice of Allahabad High Court
Aravind Kumar - Chief Justice of Gujarat High Court

Additional Information

- The centre appointed 5 new High Court Judges to the Supreme Court of India a week before.
- Judge of Supreme Court of India are appointed by the President of India under the Article 124(2) of Indian Constitution while "Judges of High Courts" are appointed under Art. 217.

- At present, the Supreme Court of India consists of 34 Judges
 (1 Chief Justice of India & 33 Judges)
- Justice Saumitra Sen (Calcutta High Court) was the first judge of Independent India.
- Justice Harilal J.Kania was the 1st Chief Justice of Independent India.

Q3) India ranks first in the Milk production, contributes 24% of global milk production.



- According to the Union Minister of Animal Husbandry and Dairy
 Purushottam Rupala announced that India ranks 1st in the Milk
 production and contributes 24% of global milk production in the
 vear 2021-22.
- The production of Milk in India has registered a growth of 51% during the last 8 years and has increased to 220 million tonnes in 2021-22.
- The department of Animal Husbandry runs various schemes to benefit the farmers in the dairy sector.
- The "National Programme for Dairy Development" was launched on February 2014 that aims to enhance the quality of milk and milk products and increasing share in the markets.

Government Initiatives in Dairy sector

- 1) <u>Rashtriya Gokul Mission</u>- it was launched in **December 2014 With a budget of Rs. 2025 crore** and aims in the development and conservation of indigenous breed.
- 2) <u>National Animal Disease Control Programme (NADCP)</u> It was launched in **September 2019** for controlling the diseases to Buffaloes, Cows, Sheeps by 100% vaccination.



Q8) RBI raises Repo rate by 25 basis points from 6.25% to 6.50%



- The Governor of RBI Shaktikanta Das headed Monetary Policy Committee(MPC) on Wednesday has raised the Repo Rate by 25 basis points to 6.50% from 6.25%.
- Repo Rate was 4% till May 2022. At present, there is an overall increase of 2.5% in Repo Rate from May 2022
- This is the sixth time that the Repo Rate has been hiked by the Reserve Bank of India.

Q9) Indore becomes first Civic body to launch Green Bonds




- Indore Municipal Corporation (IMC) has become the 1st civic body to issue
 Green Bonds.
- The corporation plans to raise **Rs. 244 crore for 60 MW solar plant** installed at Juladh Pumping Station for drinking water near Narmada river at an investment of around Rs. 305 crore.
- For this, 25 crore rupees are spent on electricity bills every month. After commissioning of this plant, the cost of electricity will be reduced by 5 to 6 crore rupees annually.

What are Green Bonds

- Green Bonds (also known as Climate bonds) are the projects that aims for renewable energy, climate control that have positive climatic benefits.
- The RBI on Friday said that 1st "sovereign green bonds (SrGB's) will be issued in **two tranches of Rs. 8,000 crore each** for green infrastructure.

- The first auction would be done on January 25 while the second auction would be done on 9 February.
- The Green bonds would be available in **5-year & 10- year tenure**.

- British Author "Salman Rushdie" has released his new novel "Victory City" published by Penguin Random House.
- It is an "epic tale" of a 14th century woman who defies a patriarchal world to rule a city.

- Jio-BP is a fuels and mobility joint venture between Reliance Industries Ltd (RIL) and BP.
- The introduction of E20 will reduce the country's oil import cost, energy security and lower carbon emission.
- The E20 fuel is a 20% blend of ethanol and 80% of fossil-based fuel.

Q14) Geological Survey of India (GSI) finds Lithium reserves in J&K.




- For the first time in the country, the GSI found Lithium reserves of 5.9 million tonnes in the Rasai district of Jammu & Kashmir.
- It further said that 51 mineral blocks including Lithium and Gold were handed over to respective state governments.
- Out of these 51 mineral blocks, 5 blocks are related to Gold and other blocks are related to Potash, Molybdenum, base metals.
- Lithium having symbol of **Li (Atomic no.-3)** is a non-ferrous metal and is one of the key components in EV batteries, mobile phones, laptops.




- The seasoned Jean Eric Vergne of DS Penske won the inaugural session of the "2023 Hyderabad E-Prix."
