Q4) Indian Men's Senior Football teams wins Intercontinental Cup 2023



- The Indian Men's Senior football player led by the captain **Sunil Chhetri** emerged victorious in the **3**<sup>rd</sup> edition of the "Intercontinental Cup 2023" by defeating Lebanon team 2-0 in the final held at the Kalinga Stadium in Bhubaneshwar, Odisha.
- This victory marks the India's second title in the Intercontinental Cup with their first title win during the inaugural edition in 2018.
- Sunil Chhetri's goal in this match marked his 87<sup>th</sup> international goal in 137 appearances for the Indian national team.
- Chhetri now hold the distinction of being the third highest goal-scorer in the international football trailing behind Portugese player Cristiano Ronaldo and Lionel Messi of Argentina.
- North Korea won the previous edition by defeating Tajikistan 1-0 in the final in 2019.



- Malaysia won the Silver medal and third place (bronze medal) was shared jointly by India and Japan.
- India was defeated by Malaysia by 3-0 in the semifinal.
- The championship was held from 13 to 17 June in Express Avenue Mall in Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
- Eight countries including India participated in the tournament Hong Kong, Japan, Malaysia, Egypt, South Africa, Australia, and Colombia.
- Egypt had won the last edition of the World Cup which was also held in Chennai in 2011.

# Q9) Bhavani Devi becomes first Indian to win Bronze medal at Asian Fencing Championships in China



- Indian star fencer Bhavani Devi has secured the Bronze medal at "Asian Fencing Championships 2023" held in Wuxi, China from 17 to 22 June 2023.
- In the quarterfinal, she created history by defeating reigning world champion
   Misaki Emura of Jap and secured India its first-ever medal at the event.
- The win confirmed the Indian fencer a historic medal.

- Indian ecosystems particularly **Mumbai**, **Bengaluru and Delhi have shown** positive growth in the rankings.
- In terms of startups, Mumbai move 5 paces to 31st while Bengaluru was ranked 20th followed by Delhi in 24th rank.

- India was ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> largest start-up in the world behind the US and China.
- India is home to as many as 75,000 startups.
- India has moved up from 81st (2015) to 46th in 2021 among 130 countries in the world.
